

We invite the submission of papers to serve on the Summit: eduJAM! 2012.

The papers will be received previously by the Program Committee. They must be submitted in writing as a summary. The Committee will then publish them on the event's website.

The following information is required: Title, Speaker's name, Brief description of the topic.

A summary of the main contributions from all the papers and the mention of the authors will be published on the event's website and in the media after the summit. Papers may be submitted by anyone who wishes to discuss a topic related to one or more of the following:

- **1. Education and ICTs:** Integration of ICTs in the educational project using Sugar and its activities. (Saturday only)
- **2. Programming and development:** discussion of features, activity programming, robotics and programming, emphasis in application development.
- **3. Connectivity and the social/educational impact:** projects involving Internet and intranets in schools, colleges and public spaces: projections and functionality, as well as independent projects involving wireless connectivity in public spaces.
- **4. Workshops:** Use of tools aimed at education and/or development in different technologies. Analysis of requirements and use cases for the subsequent solution of certain special cases in the Sugar Code Sprint
- **5. Unconference:** Free proposals of those attending that want to communicate and share with the community on Saturday.
- **6. Stands:** Free Proposals for the exhibition of work by organizations or companies (public sector or private).

- Title of the presentation
- Speaker/s
- Estimated time needed
- Summary of the subject (no more than 500 words)
